



2017 SEHA Medal Specifications

SEHA Junior Medal

Open to SEHA Junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'3" in height. One of more tests of the top 4 contestants may be required at the judge's discretion (USEF Test 1-19). To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. If you have won the SEHA Junior Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

SEHA Mini-Medal

Open to SEHA members who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year and have not competed in any horsemanship class in which the rider is required to jump higher than 3' with the exception of the USEF Pony Medal. All contestants are to compete over a course not to exceed 8 fences and not less than 6 fences at a height not to exceed 2'6". No combinations. Contestants are not allowed to cross enter into the National Children's Medal, WIHS, MHC Junior, NEHC Junior and RIHA Junior Medal, USEF Medal, USET or the ASPCA Horsemanship class at any show during the year. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. If you have won the SEHA Mini-Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

SEHA Adult Medal

Open to SEHA Amateur Adults. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" – 3' including a combination with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. At the Finals, the SEHA Adult Medal will be divided into two groups: 18-35 and Over 35. If you have won the SEHA Adult Medal at the Finals in your respective division, you are no longer eligible for this class.

SEHA Adult Mini-Medal

Open to SEHA Amateur Adults who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' in the current year. To perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the SEHA Adult Medal. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to participate at the SEHA Finals. If you have won the SEHA Adult Mini-Medal at the Finals, you are no longer eligible for this class.

SEHA Walk-Trot Medal

Exhibitors do not need to qualify to participate at the SEHA Finals but must be an active SEHA member. Exhibitors may continue to show in the SEHA Walk-Trot Medal class.

SEHA Short Stirrup Medal

Exhibitors do not need to qualify to participate at the SEHA Finals but must be an active SEHA member. Exhibitors may continue to show in the SEHA Short Stirrup Medal class.

2017 SEHA Medal Point System

Points begin to accrue on the effective date of the exhibitor’s SEHA Membership and you must be a member to show in the class. To fill a class at least 2 exhibitors must complete the course in order for points to count.

To qualify to participate at the SEHA Finals on September 17, 2017, 10 points are required.
